The Toolox history begins 12 years ago when SSAB decided to develop prehardened engineering/tool steel with excellent machining properties. Today, Toolox is increasingly appreciated at mould and die manufactures as well as for use in mechanical components. As Toolox is delivered in three strength levels; Toolox 33 at 300 HBW, Toolox 40 at 390 HBW and Toolox 44 at 450 HBW, most moulds, dies and mechanical components can be made with a suitable strength without any need of time consuming and risky heat treatment operations.

- We had developed steel with fantastic properties, but initially was our knowledge of the applications and the needs of the final customer were very limited. We felt it would be a perfect combination to co-operate with companies who have this expertise, says Ludger Weichert, Area Sales Manager of Toolox.

Logically, SSAB started to search for distributors in Northern and Central Europe. The companies were invited to join a partner network called Club Toolox. This network has grown to include 28 companies today, mainly in Europe, but also in Lebanon, Dubai, Brazil, South Africa, China and the United States.
